#### Illinois Primary Election – Tuesday, March 19 2024

It's 2024, which means another presidential election is upon us. Americans will be heading to the polls in the coming months to choose the next President of the United States. Voters will first cast their ballots in primary races and caucuses to pick the Republican and Democratic party nominees. Here, in Illinois, the primary election day is March 19th and the U.S. general election day is November 5th.

Voters in Chicago hoping to cast their ballot by mail can already apply for a mail-in ballot for the upcoming primary election. For more information voters can go here.

#### Chicago Board of Elections - Tuesday, March 19 2024

You may now apply online to **Vote by Mail** for the March 19, 2024 Presidential Primary Election by going to the following website: <a href="https://chicagoelections.gov/elections/vote-by-mail/2">https://chicagoelections.gov/elections/vote-by-mail/2</a>

To apply online, please enter your first and last name (no middle name), full address (including Street Direction, Street Name, and Street Suffix) and five number zip code to proceed. Please do not use auto-fill or leave any spaces after numerical value in the online form.

You will be asked to choose one Party ballot type for the upcoming election: Democratic, Green, Libertarian, Republican, and Non-Partisan (referenda only). Per Illinois Election Code, voters may only choose one ballot and cannot vote multiple Party ballots.

You may now also apply online to join the **Vote By Mail Permanent Roster** ahead of the March 19, 2024 Presidential Primary Election – To join the Permanent Roster go to the following website:

You may request to have your Vote by Mail ballot sent out of city or state. Choose your best option for delivery in Step 3 of the Online Application.

You may also choose to receive your Vote by Mail ballot in Spanish, Chinese, Hindi, Polish, Korean, or Tagalog in Step 4.

You may also choose to join the Accessible Vote by Mail Program in Step 4. This program allows voters with disabilities to access and mark their ballots through an online system and then print out their ballots and mail in those ballots. Please note: this is not an online voting system - the ballots in this program must be printed out and mailed to the Chicago Election Board or delivered in a Ballot Return Envelope.

When you apply online to Vote by Mail, the Board will send you emails:

- When your ballot is mailed to you,
- When the Board receives your Ballot Return Envelope, and
- When your ballot has been processed and counted.

The Board will start mailing ballots in early February 2024. All Vote by Mail ballots come with postage-paid Ballot Return Envelopes. When you receive your Vote by Mail ballot, you may return it through standard US mail and must postmark it before or on Election Day, March 19, 2024. You may also submit the Ballot Return Envelope in a secured drop box at any Early Voting Site and on Election Day. https://chicagoelections.gov/voting/early-voting
